Based on the report of the Inspectors, the Dental Council of India, *vide* their letter dated 11.6.2003, have recommended to the Central Government to grant its permission to establish a new dental college, 'Seema Dental College & Hospital', at Virpur, Rishikesh, Uttaranchal, with an annual admission capacity of 100 students in BDS Course after obtaining the Performance Bank Guarantee of Rs. 150 lakhs from the applicant.


4. On careful consideration of your scheme and inspection report and also the recommendations of the Dental Council of India, the Central Government has come to the conclusion that a Letter Of Intent may be issued to Dr. B.S. Gupta Medical Charitable Society, Rishikesh, Uttaranchal, for establishing a new dental college, 'Seema Dental College & Hospital', at Virpur, Rishikesh, Uttaranchal, with an annual intake capacity of 100 students in BDS Course from prospective effect. Hence this Letter Of Intent.

5. This Letter Of Intent is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (1) The teaching and non-teaching staff shall be recruited as per DCI norms.
- (2) The applicant has a feasible and time bound programme to provide additional equipment and infrastructure facilities as per DCI norms.
- (3) The applicant will furnish the Performance Bank Guarantee of Rs. 150 lakhs valid for 5 years in favour of DCI.
- (4) **Admission in BDS Course will be made ONLY after receipt of formal permission for starting a new dental college from the Central Government.**

6. The formal permission will be granted after you accept the above conditions and furnish the requisite Performance Bank Guarantee within 15 days of the date of this letter, failing which it will be presumed that the applicants are not interested in pursuing the subject matter and accordingly the case will be closed without further correspondence in the matter.
